Board Certified Criminal Law Specialists and Criminal Law Specialist Certification Applicants have an obligation to disclose and report the following matters at any time during the certification period or certification application process:

- Any conviction of a crime, excluding misdemeanor traffic offenses, regardless of whether the conviction was the result of a plea of guilty or *nolo contendere*, or of a verdict after a trial, and whether it resulted in imprisonment, probation, fine, or suspension of sentence;
- a Finding of Ineffective Assistance of Counsel or a Finding of Prosecutorial Misconduct entered by a District or Appellate Court;
- any formal admonishment by any Court;
- any proceeding which resulted in the Applicant or Specialist being disbarred, suspended, publicly reprimanded, sanctioned or otherwise subjected to public discipline by any disciplinary board in any jurisdiction in which an Applicant or Specialist has an active license.

All such matters must be reported to the MSBA Certified Legal Specialists Manager within thirty (30) days after they are imposed or entered. Failure to do so may be grounds for denial of certification or recertification or decertification.
